Abstract

This descriptive study, conducted during the first semester of school year 2007-2008 aimed to find out the attitude of third year cruise ship management students towards research. The participants were the randomly selected third year cruise ship management students of John B. Lacson Foundation Maritime University-Molo. Data of this study were obtained through the use of an "Attitude Towards Research Rating Scale" (Abioda, 1999). Descriptive statistics employed were the means and standard deviations, while inferential statistics used were the Pearson's r set at .05 alpha level. Results revealed that students had average attitude in research, furthermore the students attitude in research differed significantly when grouped according to Family Monthly Income.
