*Abstract*

This study aimed at determining the Career Preferences of BSCA Graduating Students. The respondents of this descriptive research were 51 senior BSCA students enrolled in John B. Lacson Foundation Maritime University-Molo, Inc. during the second semester of school year 2008-2009. The BSCA students were classified as to their sex, monthly family income, and grade point of average. Statistical tools employed were the frequency count and percentage. The study revealed that when taken as an entire group the respondents prefer to work in a Brokerage firm in Manila. Furthermore, the study showed that there was a significant relationship between the Career Preferences of BSCA Graduating Students their Sex, Monthly Family Income and General Point of Average.
