**Perceived Effects of Covid-19 Pandemic to the Academic Performance
of College Students at JBLFMU-Molo, Inc. – Iloilo City**

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Abstract

The study was designed to examine the perceived effects of COVID 19 to the academic performance of college students at JBLFMU-Molo, Inc. – Iloilo City. A survey research design was used in the study. The respondents was composed of fifty (50) first year students (both male and female) from the College of Business taking up Bachelor of Science in Cruise Ship Management at John B. Lacson Foundation Maritime University-Molo, Inc. Descriptive survey research design was used in the study. The instrument used for data collection was the researchers' made questionnaire. The data collected for the study were analyzed using frequency count and mean score. The major findings showed that the lockdown of schools as a result of the coronavirus pandemic in the Philippines have a "high effect" on students' academic performance. When grouped according to sex, male and female college students showed a "moderate effect" and "high effect" of COVID-19 pandemic to their academic performance respectively. When grouped according to place of residence, college students leaving in the City and Province showed a "moderate effect" and "high effect" of
