Abstract

The purpose of this study was to ascertain the perception towards housekeeping subject among cruise ship management students at John B. Lacson Colleges Foundation-Molo, Iloilo City for school year 2005-2006. The data of this descriptive research were gathered with the use of "Perception towards Housekeeping Subject Rating Scale" designed by the researchers. The respondents of this study were the 52 randomly selected cruise ship management students of John B. Lacson Colleges Foundation-Molo, Iloilo City. Descriptive statistics employed were the frequency count, mean, and percentage. The findings revealed that the perception towards housekeeping subject among cruise ship management students was "moderately positive" as an entire group and when grouped according to different categories.
