Abstract

This descriptive study was conducted to find out the reasons for drinking or not drinking among CSM students. The respondents of this study were the 100 BS Cruise Ship Management students of JBLFMU-Molo, as classified according to gender, place of residence, and monthly family income among drinkers and non-drinkers. As an entire group of 100 participants, 24 were male and 76 were female, who do drinking or not drinking alcoholic beverages. Among the respondents 75 were exposed to drinking, while 25 respondents were not. As to place of residence, many were from the rural areas; as to monthly family income, many respondents who drink had average monthly family income, while respondents who did not drink had low income.
