Abstract

This descriptive study was conducted to determine the work relationship among the employees of Hotel Del Rio in Iloilo City. The respondents were thirty (30) purposively selected employees of Hotel Del Rio and they were grouped according to sex, number of year in service, and designated departments. A validated researcher-made questionnaire checklist was used in the gathering of data. The statistical tools used were means, standard deviation, t-test and F-test (ANOVA). The findings of the study revealed that the level of work relationship among the employees of Hotel Del Rio when taken as an entire group with both sex (male and female), years in service and their designated department were "high". There was no significant difference in the work relationship among the employees of Hotel Del Rio, Iloilo City when respondents were classified according to sex, years in service, and their department assigned.
